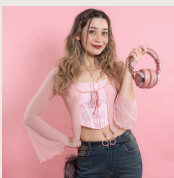

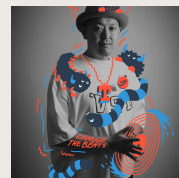
DJ LUCY

Her DJ style is based on hip-hop and R&B, while also mixing across genres such as '80s funk/soul, old school from the '90s to early 2000s, as well as the latest trap music and pop. With her unique bilingual selection and groove, she captivates audiences wherever she plays. Based primarily in Sapporo, she has been deejaying at nightclubs and music events across Hokkaido, while also expanding her activities to Tokyo. In 2022, she appeared twice on "ABEMA Mix". That same year, she made her radio DJ debut on FM NORTH WAVE. On the music program "Satsueki-mae Bangers," she shows her musical tastes and engaging talk skills, hosting a three-hour live broadcast and bringing in Banger music. Since 2022, she has served as the Home DJ for Levanga Hokkaido, and in 2024, she was officially selected as the F VILLAGE DJ, hyping up the crowd with her DJ performances at ES CON Field HOKKAIDO before Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters games.

A consummate professional who connects people of all backgrounds and music fans from Sapporo to the world through the craft of DJing — that is DJ TAMA a.k.a. SPC FINEST. Since 2009 he has toured internationally every year, performing across Thailand, the United States, South Korea, Vietnam, Myanmar, Taiwan, Hong Kong, and China. In 2024 he completed a successful European run with eight shows across the UK and Switzerland. His reach extends beyond clubs: he's the home-game DJ for B.League team Levanga Hokkaido and has fired up audiences at sporting events including the Ski Jumping World Cup, Red Bull 400, and wheelchair basketball CP3x3.

He performs both as a solo artist and as OHSUNSHINE, a project in which he writes, composes, and produces his own work, appearing at festivals in Japan and abroad. He is a founding member, guitarist, and composer of Tokyo Jihen, and has been active as a recording and supporting musician for artists such as Elephant Kashimashi, Superfly, MONORAL, and PLENTY. In recent years, he has been based in Sapporo, performing at events including the Hokkaido Nippon-Ham Fighters' ES CON Field Christmas event, "Everyone's Christmas Music Festival."
